

Energy: Explosive Regulation Guidelines

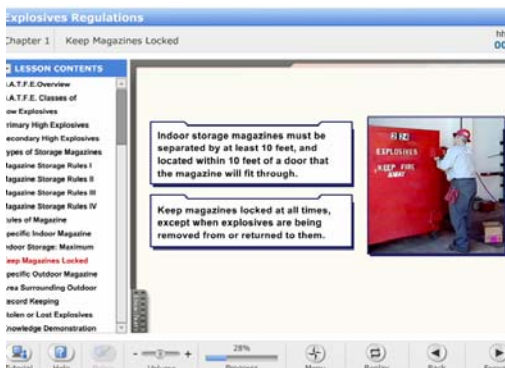
This industry-specific course provides an introduction to the rules, regulations, and safe handling procedures governing explosives used in oil and gas exploration.
