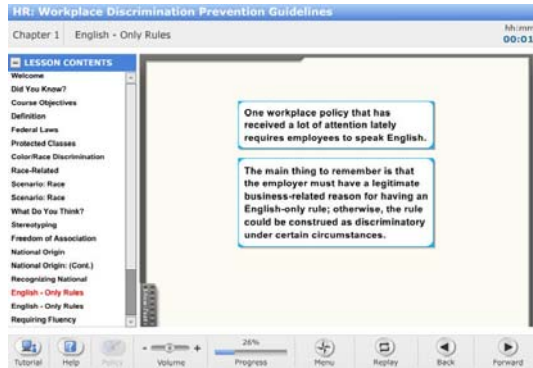


HR: Workplace Discrimination Prevention Guidelines

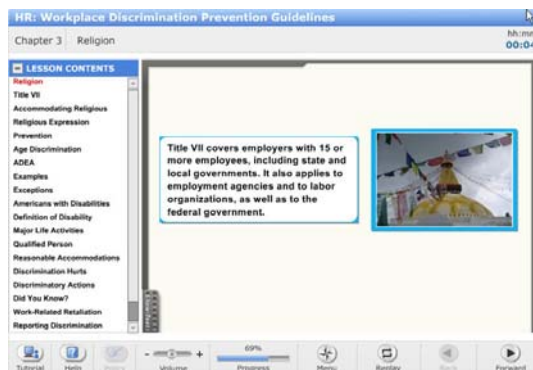
