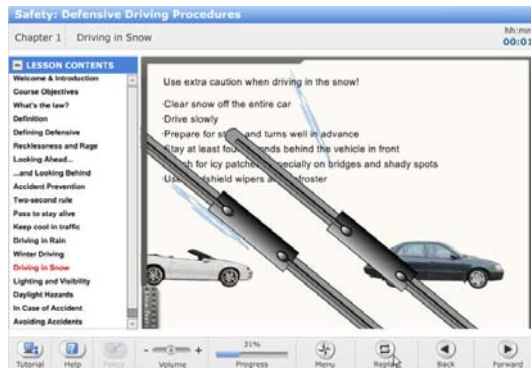


Safety: Defensive Driving Procedures
