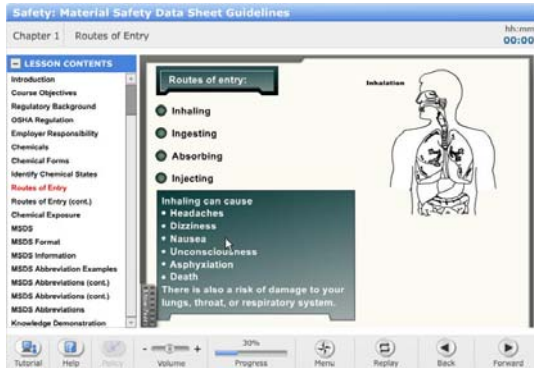


Safety: Material Safety Data Sheet Guidelines
